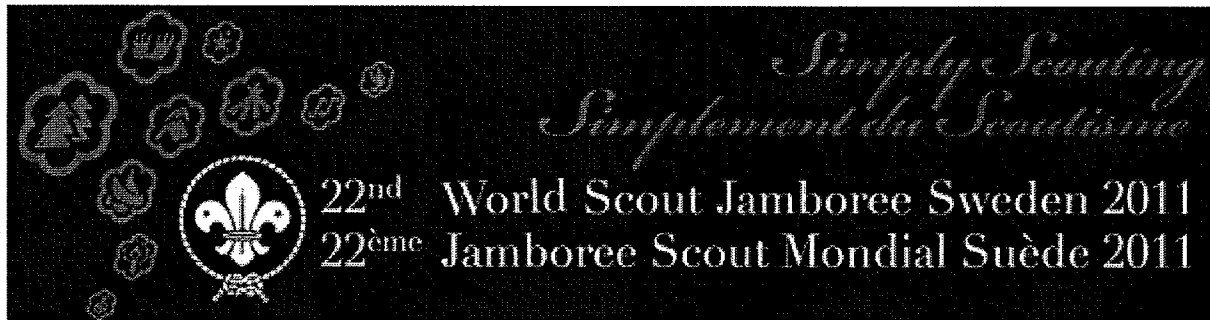


International Scouting Opportunities Farther out



The next World Scout Jamboree will be held in Rinkaby-Kristianstad in southern Sweden from July 27th to August 7th, 2011. This is the same place their last two National Jamborees were held. It is only a short distance from Copenhagen, Denmark. The cost for US participants is expected to be about \$4,500 with touring and sightseeing included. With the Swedish ties for many people in Minnesota, this would be an excellent Jamboree to start planning and saving money for.



If Sweden is not what you want to do in 2011, another interesting Scouting event will be the Peruvian National Jamboree which will be held in Cuzco only a short distance from Machu Picchu. The Jamboree will celebrate 100 years of Scouting in Peru. It will probably overlap with the World Jamboree in Sweden, as it is currently planned to correspond with their National Day, which is on July 28th. The cost will probably be about 1/2 of going to the World Jamboree.



16th Nippon Jamboree July-August 2013

This will be a pre-Jamboree for the 23rd World Scout Jamboree in 2015. It will be held at Kirara Beach in Yamaguchi Prefecture and will have the same program as the World Jamboree. This is a beautiful landscape in front of which the Seto Inland Sea, which glitters in the sunlight just like mica. The cost for attending will be less than 1/2 of attending the World Jamboree and homestays with Nagasaki Scouts is expected.

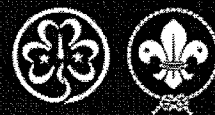
13th Pan American Jamboree



From December 26th, 2009 to January 3rd, 2010 Scouts from around the Americas and other parts of the world will be at the Sierra Morelos National Park near Toluca, Mexico (65 km SW of Mexico City). There, they will be exploring new territories, living their spirit, helping in service projects, experiencing new cultures, doing sightseeing, enjoying a New Year's party, and just having fun with Scouts from other countries.

The cost for this adventure of a lifetime is expected to be about \$1,200. The actual cost will depend on airfare. Youth participants must be between 13 and 17 years old. People over 18 can sign up for staff, but positions are limited. If there is enough interest, both a Council Contingent Scout Troop and Venture Crew will be sent to the event.

ROVERWAY 2009 *in Iceland*



Roverway 2009 is for Scouts and Venturers age 16-20. The first four days of the event will be spent touring Iceland in groups of 50 people from different countries. The groups will then converge at the Ulfljotsvatn Scout Center in southern Iceland where they will camp together and have a mini Jamboree type program. The activity dates are July 20-28. Additional sightseeing in Reykjavik and other parts of the country are possibilities either before or after. Estimated cost is \$1,800. urSPRUNG Austrian Jamboree

August 3-12, 2010. Over 8,000 Scouts will be camping at Laxenburg castle near Vienna, Austria. Activities will include hiking in the fresh mountain air, swimming in crystal clear lakes, cycling along the Danube river and sightseeing in Vienna. Youth must be between 13 and 20 years old. The estimated cost is \$1,800.
